How to Use the Autohaler



Instructions:

- 1. Remove the cap from the Autohaler inhaler.
- 2. Shake the inhaler upright and shake well.
- 3. Hold the inhaler upright and push the lever up until it clicks into place.
- 4. Breathe out gently way from the inhaler.
- 5. Place the mouthpiece of the inhaler between your teeth without biting the mouthpiece. Close your lips around the mouthpiece to form a good seal.
- 6. Breathe in slowly and deeply. Keep breathing in after you hear a click. The click means that the medicine is released.
- 7. Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as is comfortable.
- 8. While holding your breath, remove the inhaler from your mouth.
- 9. Breathe out gently away from the inhaler.
- 10. Push the lever down.
- 11. If more than one dose is needed, repeat steps starting from step 2.
- 12. Replace the cap on the inhaler.

Tips:

- Keep your chin up and the inhaler upright. Do not aim the inhaler at the roof of your mouth or tongue.
- Always lift the lever before using the inhaler.
- Always place the cover back on the inhaler after use.
- If you are using this inhaler for a corticosteroid preventer medication, rinse your mouth with water and spit after inhaling the last dose to reduce the risk of side-effects.
