## How to Use the Metered Dose Inhaler (MDI) with a Spacer



## **Instructions:**

- 1. Remove the cap from the inhaler. Some must be squeezed at the sides to release.
- 2. Remove the cap from the spacer.
- 3. Check the dose counter if the inhaler has one.
- 4. Hold the inhaler upright and shake well.
- 5. Insert the inhaler into the open end of the spacer. Ensure that the inhaler fits properly.
- 6. Sit straight or stand up.
- 7. Tilt your head back slightly.
- 8. Exhale away from the inhaler.
- 9. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth without biting it. Close your lips around the mouthpiece to form a good seal.
- 10. Press the inhaler once and take a deep and slow breath.
- 11. Remove the inhaler from your mouth.
- 12. Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable.
- 13. Exhale slowly through your mouth or nose away from the inhaler.
- 14. Repeat steps 4-13 after 30 seconds if another dose is required.
- 15. If more than one dose is needed, repeat all steps starting from step 3.
- 16. Replace the cap.

## Tips:

• If you are using this inhaler for a corticosteroid preventer medication, rinse your mouth with water and spit after inhaling the last dose to reduce the risk of side-effects.

## **Cleaning:**

- Clean your spacer before you use it for the first time and then about once a month.
- It's not unusual for your spacer to look a bit cloudy.
- Wash you spacer in warm water with kitchen detergent and allow to air dry without rinsing.
- Drying with a cloth or paper towel can result in electrostatic charge on the inside of the spacer, which make the medication stick to the sides.
- Wipe the mouthpiece clean of detergent before use.
