## LOSS/CONTAMINATION OF WATER SUPPLY

If water supply is disrupted or contaminated for any reason, the following steps will be taken by staff on duty until the restoration of a safe water supply.

## Procedure:

- 1. All efforts will be made to determine the cause for water disruption and the probable length of shutdown and if a "Boil Water" order has been issued.
- 2. Shut down any and all ice dispensing, coffee, tea and water dispensing machines that use the contaminated water source.
- 3. Obtain a copy of the Boil Water procedures from, the appropriate department of Public Health.
- 4. Contact patients in affected area and review Boil Water procedures.
- Suggest use of bottled water, canned juices and other fluids for consumption by patient, with consideration of any dietary restrictions.
- 6. Use disposable dishes and utensils, if possible.
- 7. Use bottled water/boiled water for handwashing and food prep.
- 8. If it becomes apparent that a water shortage will last for an extended length of time, emergency measures may be issued by the state.
- 9. Continue to monitor patients for ongoing needs.
