## **POWER OUTAGE**

In the event of a power outage, the following steps should be followed:

## **Procedure:**

- 1. Immediately contact any patient that requires oxygen concentrators or other life support equipment. Determine if they have a home generator to supply power to equipment.
- 2. In the event, that the patient does not have emergency back-up power, determine:
  - Amount of time that power is expected to be out
  - Whether the power company can take immediate steps to restore power to patient
  - Call 211 to identify nearest shelter location and determine if patient can be transferred to local shelter or requires evacuation to area hospital.
- 3. In the event that the patient will need to be moved to a hospital, contact 911 and your area Emergency Response Coordinator for assistance as needed (see chart below).
