Billerica MA	“Unwanted Medication Kiosk” in lobby of Billerica Police Department. Accepts sealed plastic bags with medication.	No sharps or liquids
Danvers MA	Padlocked mailbox in lobby of police station @ 120 Ash Street. Accepts sealed plastic bags with medication.	Remove labels from containers. No sharps Liquids in bottles in sealed bags.
Dracut MA	Kiosk in lobby of Dracut Police Department @ 110 Loon Hill Road.	No liquids or sharps. Bag containing pills no larger than two slices of bread. Accessible 24/7

Haverhill, MA	Kiosk in Lobby of Haverhill Police Department @ 40 Bailey Boulevard	Available 24/7
Ipswich MA	Drop off box at Ipswich Police Department @ 15 Elm Street

Lowell MA	Kiosk located at Lowell Police Department. Accepts sealed plastic bags with medication.	No sharps or liquids Bags no larger than 1 and one quarter inch
Newburyport MA	Front lobby at Newburyport Police Department @ 4 Green Street	No IV solutions, injectables or needles. No illicit substances such as marijuana or methamphetamines. Available 24/7
North Andover MA	Kiosk at North Andover Police Department @ 1475 Osgood Street	Available 24/7
Reading MA	Non controlled medications – Walgreen’s Pharmacy @ 17 Harnden Street Controlled Substances - Police Department @15 Union Street	Two separate locations for non controlled and controlled substances
Salem NH	Kiosk in Lobby of Police Department @ 9 Veterans Memorial Parkway	Available 24/7
Westford MA	Westford Police Department 24-hour drop box in lobby Accepts sealed plastic bags with medication.	No sharps, medications in a syringe liquids, IV bags, inhalers, thermometers, hydrogen peroxide, personal care products
Windham NH	Police Department 4 Fellows Road	
York Maine	Kiosk lobby York PD 36 Main St	Available 24/7 No sharps, liquids IV bags, inhalers, thermometers
