ITEM INTENT
Identifies patient characteristics that may indicate the patient is at risk for hospitalization in the care provider's professional judgment.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select all responses 1-6 that apply.</li> <li>• If Response 7 is selected, none of the other responses should be selected.</li> <li>• Response 3 includes witnessed and reported (unwitnessed) falls.</li> <li>• In Response 4, medications includes OTC medications.</li> <li>• Recent decline in mental, emotional, or behavioral status refers to significant changes occurring over the past year that may impact the patient's ability to remain safely in the home and increase the likelihood of hospitalization.</li> <li>• Frailty includes weight loss in the last year, self-reported exhaustion, and slower movements (sit to stand and while walking).</li> </ul>
