

<b>OASIS ITEM</b>
<p><b>(M1034) Overall Status:</b> Which description best fits the patient's overall status? <b>(Check one)</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 0 - The patient is stable with no heightened risk(s) for serious complications and death (beyond those typical of the patient's age).</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 1 - The patient is temporarily facing high health risk(s) but is likely to return to being stable without heightened risk(s) for serious complications and death (beyond those typical of the patient's age).</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 2 - The patient is likely to remain in fragile health and have ongoing high risk(s) of serious complications and death.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 3 - The patient has serious progressive conditions that could lead to death within a year.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> UK - The patient's situation is unknown or unclear.</p>
<b>ITEM INTENT</b>
Identifies the general potential for health status stabilization, decline, or death in the care provider's professional judgment.
<b>TIME POINTS ITEM(S) COMPLETED</b>
Start of care Resumption of care
<b>RESPONSE—SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use information from other providers and clinical judgment to select the response that best identifies the patient's status.</li> <li>• Consider current health status, medical diagnoses, and information from the physician and patient/family on expectations for recovery or life expectancy.</li> <li>• A "Do Not Resuscitate" order does not need to be in place for Responses 2 or 3.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Patient/caregiver interview</li> <li>• Physician</li> <li>• Review of health history</li> <li>• Referral information</li> <li>• Physical assessment</li> <li>• Advance Directive</li> </ul>
