The Pneumococcal Vaccine information is one of the Star Rating & Value Based Purchasing questions. The information below will give you guidance for answering the question.

M1051

Has the patient ever had the Pneumococcal Vaccine?

- Yes or No

M1056

Reason Pneumococcal Vaccine not received

- 1 - Offered and declined
- 2 - Assessed and determined to have medical contraindications
- 3 - Not indicated; patient does not meet age/condition guidelines
- 4 - None of the above

Contraindications

- Anaphylactic hypersensitivity to components of the vaccine
- Acute a febrile illness
- Bone marrow transplant within the last 12 months
- Chemo or radiation within the last 2 weeks
- MD restriction

**Age criteria/Guidelines

- All adults 65 years or older
- Anyone 2-64 that has a long term health problem such as: heart disease, lung disease, sickle cell disease, diabetes, lymphoma, or leukemia, kidney failure, multiple myeloma, nephritic syndrome ,HIV or Aids, damaged spleen, or no spleen, or organ transplant

Documentation

- You **must** obtain this information at SOC from the patient, family, caregiver, or MD
- If you are unable to obtain the information you must pass this along to the primary clinician or manager for follow up
- You must enter the information in the vaccine tab of the Oasis
- To enter information about a declined/contraindicated or pt request for further information on the vaccine ,check the “custom” box in the immunization tab ,” then enter PN vaccine declined, contraindicated, or state that the pt would like to get the PN shot(which ever applies), in the box under category box (NOT IN THE NOTES section) section
- Be specific if pt has a contraindication, doesn't meet criteria, refuses or would like information on the PN vaccine
